We are pleased to announce the 33<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the Nordic Neuropaediatric Society in Denmark.

The programme will focus on stroke, cerebral palsy, Tourette syndrome, neuromuscular diseases, ADHD, and epilepsy. It is designed for paediatricians, paediatric neurologists, and trainees interested in paediatric neurology, with emphasis on clinical settings.

Confirmed invited speakers include Vijeya Ganesan (London), Allan Colver (UK), Kerstin Plessen (Bergen), Már Tulinius (Uppsala), and Sameer Zuberi (Glasgow). We have arranged interactive "Meet the Expert" sessions to optimize transfer of knowledge to your daily clinical practice.

The venue, Comwell Borupgaard, is beautifully situated in Snekkersten, close to Øresund, and close to Helsingør in scenic Northern Zealand. It is a short travel distance to exciting attractions including Kronborg Castle, Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, and Copenhagen. ## Abstracts

We welcome abstracts within all areas of paediatric neurology. All abstracts should be written, submitted and presented in English only. Please send abstracts to [thomas.balslev@viborg.rm.dk](mailto:thomas.balslev@viborg.rm.dk) Deadline is April 28, 2010.

1. Abstracts should be no longer than 250 words (this limit excludes the abstract title, authors and institutions)
2. The first name in each abstract should be that of the presenting author
3. Institution information should be provided for all authors. Include institution, city, state/province and country but do not include department, division, laboratory, etc
4. Abstracts should be structured in 4 sections: Purpose, method, results and conclusion
5. Instructions for both platform and poster presentations will be made available with notices of acceptance
6. All abstracts accepted for presentation at the congress will be printed in the congress abstract book

## Poster prize

A presentation by poster can be an effective way to share the results of your research with your colleagues in an interactive and non-threatening atmosphere. The best poster presented by a trainee will be awarded with DKK 5.000.
